A prayer wheel is a cylindrical wheel on a spindle made from metal, wood, stone, leather, or coarse cotton, widely used in Tibet and areas where Tibetan culture is predominant. Worshippers turn prayer wheels to accumulate merit, to help all the beings in the world and to purify their karma (international actions).

Just hours before Winter Olympics 2022 kicked off in Beijing, Tibetans living in Delhi staged a massive protest. Burning Chinese flags outside the Chinese embassy in the national capital and raising slogans of 'Bharat Mata Ki Jai', Tibetans marched in protest of the human rights violation in China. Earlier, a drama was staged by the activists for Students for Free Tibet in Dharamshala, where they termed the Olympics 'Genocide 2022'. The protests in India were a part of a global movement calling out China for its atrocities in Uyghurs.
