- **Tibetan Activist Urges the International Community to Recognise Tibetan Government-in-Exile**

London-based Founder and Chairman of the Global Alliance for Tibet & Persecuted Minorities (GATPM), Tsering Passang has urged leading democracies including India, the UK, and the USA to recognize Dharamsala-based Central Tibetan Administration as the "Tibetan Government-in-Exile" and its overseas agencies (Offices of Tibet) as full-fledged Embassies. 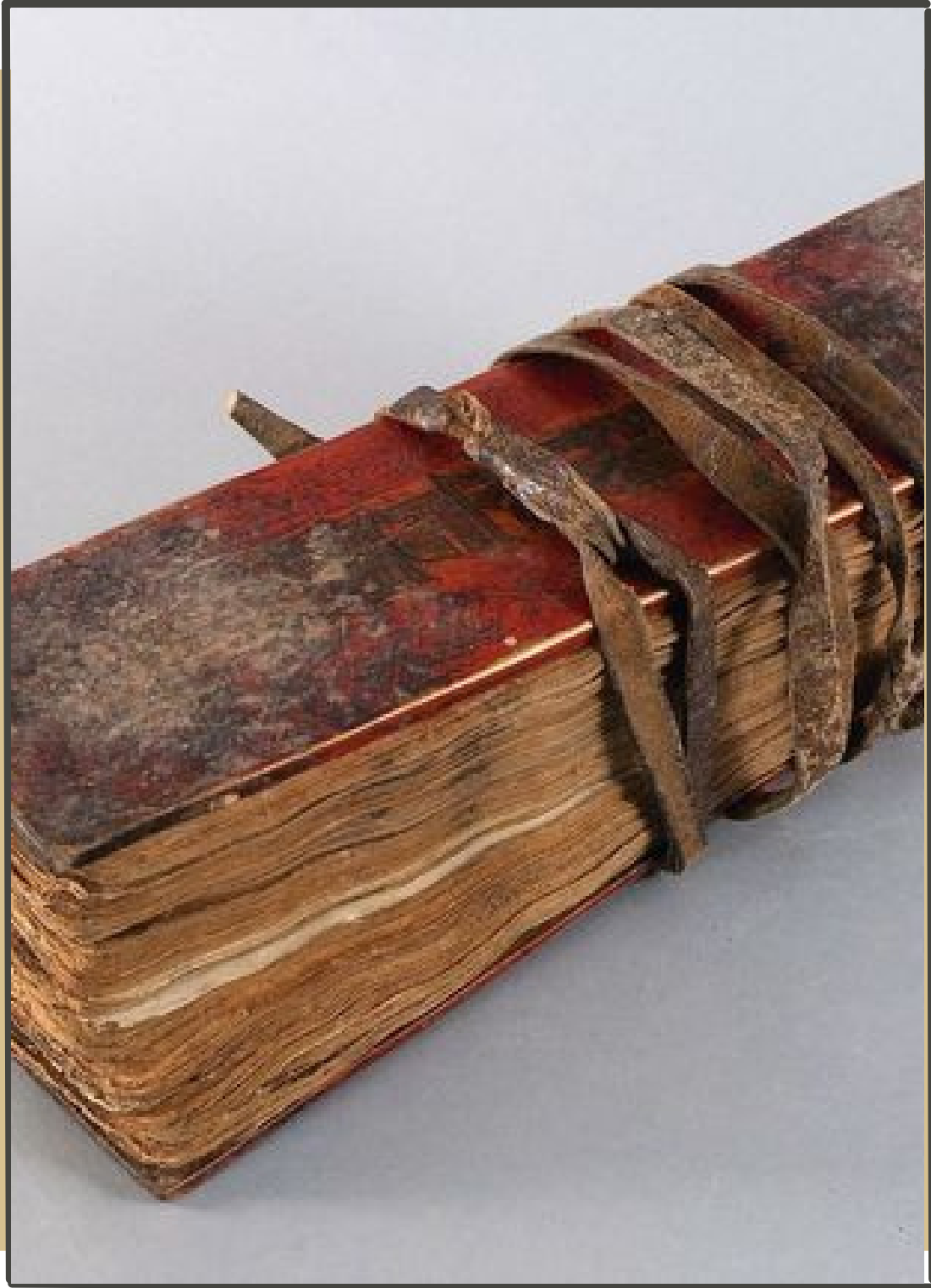
